The Memorial of the
Undersigned Members of
Council Bankers Merchants
Traders and others European and
Chinese inhabitants of Ararat
and its Vicinity.

Most respectfully Sheweth

1. That this Gold field was originally discovered by Chinese Miners and thence received the name of the "Canton Lead".
2. That since then and until lately a large Chinese population has been located in the District.
3. That during the whole time their conduct has been good while the duties payable by them have been rigidly enforced by the authorities.
4. That since one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine the diggings have gradually diminished in value and at the present time hardly produce sufficient for the sustenance of the untaxed Miners far less for the payment of the heavy duties especially chargeable on the Chinese.
5. That owing to the causes aforesaid the European Mining population has nearly disappeared while the Chinese population has become diminished from three thousand to less than five hundred souls and from the same causes

- added to the rigid collection of the residence duty of Four pounds per annum is daily diminishing.
6. That in consequence the material interests of this Town - the value of property - the trade of the place and the prosperity of the inhabitants are greatly affected.
7. That in our opinion the residence tax levied upon the Chinese population is both unwise impolitic and unjust.
8. That we believe such tax to be a violation of the Law of Nations and of the treaties at present existing between the two Imperial Governments and ought to be abolished.
9. That even if otherwise it is at least partial and unjust and is levied from and presses most heavily upon the poorest and most helpless class who are least able to bear it.
10. That if the necessities of the State forbid an immediate abolition of the whole duty it ought at least as an instalment of justice and an admission of scinder political views to be greatly reduced.
11. That we believe that if the tax in question were reduced to one half say Two pounds per annum and collected throughout the Colony with the same strictness as here that a much larger gross amount would be paid into the Treasury than is at present collected at the heavy rate of Four pounds per head.
12. That the tax for the past two quarters of this year has been generally collected in this District.
13. That the paorness of the diggings - the poverty of the Chinese and the inclemency of the season would in our opinion render a further collection of the duty during this and the ensuing quarter at least unwise incensidate and harsh.
14. That in fact in our opinion the further collection of the duty from the Chinese in this District ought to be stayed until a reconsidetation of the question of the reduction of the duty by the Legislature shall take place as hereinafter referred to.
15. That in the event of such reduction the duty of Five pounds already paid by the Chinese of this District in respect of the past two quarters of this year should exempt them from any further payment during the present year and should be deemed as their annual payment at the reduced rate.

Dear Memorialists therefore most respectfully pray that your Excellency in Council will direct that a clause may be introduced into one of the Bills now before

Parliament reducing the Residence Tax
upon the Chinese from Four pounds to
Five pounds per annum - that such
reductions shall take effect so that the
payments already made during the
current year may be deemed payment
thereunder and that the further collection
be until such measure be passed may
be stayed.
